## **VACCINATED FANS**

- 1. Download YOUR vaccination certificate before coming to the stadium
- 2. Bring your ID
- 3. Bring you match ticket- tickets for the Nedbank cup fixtures are available at ticketpro outlets countrywide
- 4. Booster doses are also available for fans that have received 2 Pfizer doses and the JnJ Vaccine

## **FANS NOT VACCINATED**

- 1. Arrive early at the stadium
- 2. Bring your proof of identity (ID, birth certificate, Passport, etc.)
- 3. Bring your match ticket
- 4. After vaccinating you will receive your vaccination card which will be required at the gate for you to enter the stadium
- 5. Register on the electronic vaccination data system (EVDS) to save time
- 6. Observe yourself for any side effects

## **FOR ALL FANS**

- 1. Maintain hand hygiene and Sanitise your hands regularly
- 2. Keep social distance
- 3. Let's get vaccinated, it is the only way to remain in a viable creative and sporting economy
